- 1. Understanding the New Testament Environment implies having a background of Judaism in the Diaspora. Give a brief synthesis of Judaism in the Diaspora and its importance with regard to the proclamation of the Good News.
- 2. Women figure most extensively in the Hebrew Bible. In what ways is their presentation therein still valid in the third millennium?
- 3. How is traditional Messianism interpreted by the modern Jewish Movements e.g. Reform, Conservative, Humanistic Judaism and how do they basically differ from the Orthodox Movements?
- 4. Is there evidence of anti-Judaism in the Gospel of Matthew or in the Gospel of Luke which indicates that all thought of Israel as the people of God had been abandoned? Discuss.
- 5. Explain why the Paschal Mystery constitutes the apex of the life and mission of the self-forgetful Christ, the obedient servant of the Father and of his fellow men and women.
- 6. Epictetus, Pythagoras, Epicurus, the Stoics, and St Anthony the Abbot... Write an essay describing some of the distinctive ideals of the life of these exponents. How did they mould a particular movement in Christianity in the fourth century CE?
- 7. Describe how any <u>two</u> narratives in Genesis are structured in order to show the narrative art produced by their biblical writers.
