The five models Avery Dulles gives are: revelation as doctrine, history, inner experience, dialectical presence, and new awareness. Comment with reference to ANY TWO of these models.
3. “The deepest truth about God and the salvation of human beings is made clear to us in Christ who is the mediator and at the same time the fullness of all revelation” (Dei Verbum, n. 2). Explain with reference to the dynamic aspect of this same revelation that continues to be mediated in the living tradition of the Church.
