To choose TWO questions:

1. Christian living can be seen as a continuing attempt on the part of oneself to explore the significance of being situated in a narrative and in a community that begins and is sustained in and by God. Explain.
2. In what sense can God's call to man be understood as a call to self-realization?
3. In order that we can properly relate to ourselves, to others and to God and to live our life, in its past, present and future dimensions, in an integrated manner we need to cultivate virtuous dispositions. Explain.
4. Discuss why it is necessary for conscience to be open to moral truth in order to be able to judge well in the various situations of life.
