Section A:

- 1) The sexuality of man and woman drives them out of themselves to seek relationships with others. Discuss.
- 2) Once a responsible decision has been reached regarding family limitation, there remains the further decision regarding the method for achieving it. Discuss.
- 3) Discuss how sexual morality can be approached from a deontological and teleological perspective. Illustrate your arguments with examples.

Section B:

- 4) Discuss the biblical insights on marriage and their contribution to the development of sacramental theology of marriage.
- 5) For many centuries marriage was seen more as an institution rather than as an interpersonal reality. Discuss the paradigm shift introduced by 'personalist theologians' in the theology of marriage.
- 6) It is claimed that marital breakdown and second marriage challenges our theology of marriage and our belief in the indissolubility of marriage. Discuss.
