1. Should penance and reconciliation be a private affair between the individual and God? In your opinion, is the canonical discipline and the pastoral practice of the Church necessary?
2. During the last decades, the anointing of the sick was recaptured in all its richness. How was this sacrament eclipsed over the centuries?
3. The sacrament of marriage is susceptible to various social and cultural factors. How do these factors effect its theological and anthropological aspects?
